Helpful tips:

- The Girl Scout Bronze Award must be completed by September 30th immediately following the girls' graduation/completion from the 5th grade. Keep in mind, if girls work as a group on a project, the deadline is determined by the oldest girl(s) in the group, because the project must be completed together with all group members.
- To earn the Girl Scout Bronze Award, this form must be completed (one per project) with the individual girl Time Logs and emailed to customercare@gssef.org.
- Each Girl Scout is required to submit an individual Time Log with a **minimum** of 20 hours. (Page 5)
- Incomplete forms will be returned.
- One Troop Leader **and** the Service Unit Volunteer Manager must sign this form **prior** to submission.
- Following approval, Leaders may purchase the Girl Scout Bronze Award Pin and official patch at one of our GSSEF Retail Stores.
